Please support your child by ensuring they arrive at school on time for school to ensure they are not missing important learning.

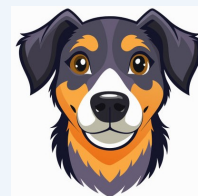
Our school gates are locked at 08:45am.
